**Meeting Worlds of Words:  
a Fulbright experience in Arizona, U.S.A.**

“In October 2019 I flew to Austin Texas to attend the United States International Board on Books for Young People (USBYP) regional conference, and this marked the start of four months based at the Worlds of Words Collection at the University of Arizona with Professor Kathy Short. At the heart of Fulbright New Zealand Scholarship awards is the notion of exchange. My proposal emphasised that I wanted to learn how to develop the Waikato Picturebook Research Unit based on the Worlds of Words Center. In this presentation I will describe the application process and how I developed the teaching and research programme in my proposal. I will also share some experiences from the Fulbright Fellowship, introducing you to the Worlds of Words Collection, the Children’s Literature Assembly within NCTE, and the Guadalajara Book Festival.”

Nicola is a Senior Lecturer in the Division of Education at the University of Waikato, where she teaches courses in children’s literature and language learning and pedagogy. She is the Co-director of the Waikato Picturebook Research Unit. Her research focus is multilingual picturebooks.
